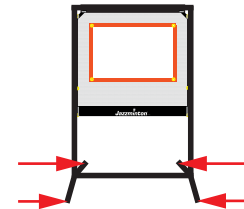
2pcs - L Shape Connectors
Location: **Top Bar Corners**



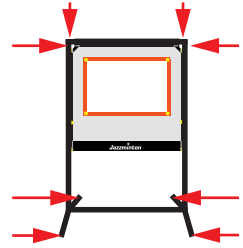
2pcs - 4 Way Connectors
Location: **Bottom Corners**



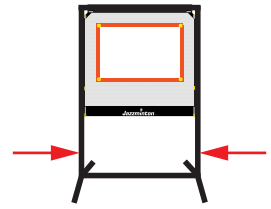
4pcs - Feet Covers
Location: **Short Bottom Tubes**



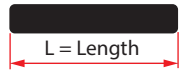
8pcs- Tube Elastic Rope Holders
Location: **Inside tube ends see red points**



2pcs - Tube Storage
Location: **Sides of Frame**



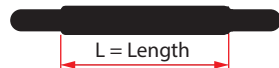
15 pcs Steel Tube



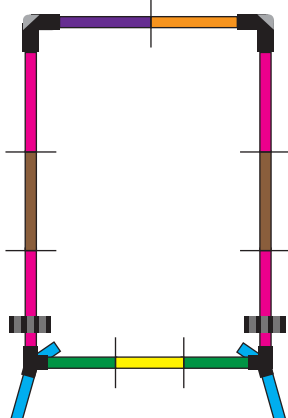
- 4 pcs L = $28\frac{3}{8}$ " - 72cm
- 1 pcs L = $28\frac{5}{8}$ " - 72.7cm
- 4 pcs L = $28\frac{1}{8}$ " - 51cm
- 1 pcs L = $10\frac{1}{4}$ " - 26cm



- 1 pcs L = $28\frac{5}{8}$ " - 72.7cm
- 2 pcs L = $22\frac{7}{8}$ " - 58cm



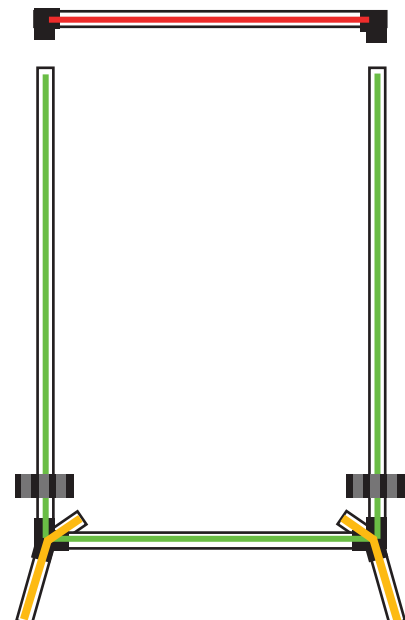
- 2 pcs L = $28\frac{3}{8}$ " - 72cm



4 Bungee Ropes inside Tubes



- 1 pcs = aprox. $39\frac{3}{8}$ " - 100cm
- 1 pcs = aprox. 189" - 480cm
- 2 pcs = aprox. $30\frac{6}{8}$ " - 78cm
