

How to Assemble

First Time: Approx. 5-10 minutes

After 3-5 Times: 1 minute

Remove from Carry Bag: Frame - Top Bar - Net.








Unfold the Frame tubes from the two Foam Holders. (Foam Holders stay on Frame)



Plug tubes together - they are connected with bungee ropes for simplicity.



Make sure legs are fully pushed in (Note: the fit is tight to ensure the frame is stable)



Place the Net between the Frame like this, ensuring the word "Jazzminton" matches image.










Remove one 2-Way-Connector from the Top Bar.




Place the 2-Way-Connector back onto the Top Bar.



Connect the 2-Way-Connector to the Frame.



Attach the two bungee cords to the eyelets at the bottom of the Net. This is to stretch out the Net.

Setup

Minimum space needed: 8 x 18 feet - (2.40 x 5.50m)

Standard Setup: (indoors and outdoors without wind)




Jazzminton Sport is best played using the S10, S20 or S30 Birdie.

The reason for this is because every hit, no matter how hard, CAN be returned.

The S10, S20 and S30 are designed to slow down as it flies, allowing you time to react in order to return it. Since this is the case, there are no boundary lines needed, making for awesome rallies.

Choose the birdie you prefer.



Windy Conditions Setup

If it is windy, we have also provided Sport Wind Birdies and Yellow/Red Balls to play with. In this case, we suggest you set up the boundary line, because hitting the Sport Wind Birdies or Yellow/Red Balls as hard as you can, is difficult to return. These boundaries limit the distance of your shot, so you don't just blast it away, making for great rallies.

Alternative Setup (ONLY for windy conditions)

Use the Anchor Rope and the Anchor Hooks to secure down.

Set up boundaries so each player has a court size of 16' x 16' (4.8m x 4.8m).

Use one of these:

wind birdie

yellow ball

or red ball

Jazzminton is easy to learn

Practice and Learn Jazzminton Sport

Below are two steps to help you in your Jazzminton Sport journey.

FIRST STEP - Get comfortable with the birdies

Pass a birdie back and forth without the Net until you can rally easily.

Try to pass the birdie to the other player's paddle as close as you can, this trains you to direct the birdie where you want it to go.


Do this step until you feel comfortable and then move to the second step.




SECOND STEP

Pass the Sport Birdie back and forth through the Window until you can rally easily.

Once you are comfortable with this step, you can graduate to competitive games with score keeping.







Rules

Objective: To win points by hitting a birdie/ball through the Jazzminton window until opponent cannot return it.

Determine Who Starts

Players rally, hitting the birdie/ball through the Jazzminton window, the winner of the rally gets the first serve.

Serving

Serving player is a minimum of 6 feet from the Jazzminton net and must underhand serve the birdie/ball. (See image). When serving, if the birdie/ball touches the net and goes through the window, it does not count and you must redo the serve. If it happens 2 times in a row, you lose the point.

Receiving player may stand at any desired distance.

Serve Alternating

If the game is to 11, each player alternates 2 serves at a time. If the game is to 21, each player alternates 5 serves at a time.

If the score is 10-10 (played to 11 points) or 20-20 (played to 21 points), both players alternate one serve each until the game is won.

During Play

Using only your paddle you get one hit to return the birdie/ball through the window. To equalize sun and wind effects, switch sides every 5 points, if desired.

Scoring

Jazzminton is played using rally scoring. Points can be won when serving or receiving. The rally ends and a point is awarded when the opponent cannot return the birdie/ball through the Jazzminton Window. If the birdie touches the net but still goes through the window, play continues as normal. (as long it was not on the serve)

Games are typically played to 11 or 21.

Games must be won by two points.

Alternative Scoring


You can only score when you are serving. (Traditional scoring, as in pickleball)

Underhand

Schools and Gym

26 students can play at the same time.

Each Jazzminton Court is 8 feet x 23 feet (2.5m x 7m)
(plenty of room around each group)





Storage

For quick storage, fold legs into foam holders. Store it in a dry, room temperature environment.

To ensure your net lasts for years, avoid leaving it in the sun or rain when not in use.





Maintenance

Cleaning - you can clean all parts with a household glass cleaner.

If your birdie starts to look like this after playing: (Keep in mind these are real goose feathers)



Place the feather between thumb and index finger and gently move outwards, one feather at a time.

movement with fingers to straighten it out

For best results, use a tiny amount of hand cream or olive oil.

In case a feather falls out, you can use super glue to re-attach.


